For a period of 10 years, Julie was the BBC Radio's 'Cambridgeshire Farmhouse Cook' and she is a regular contributor to BBC Local Radio channels and the Satellite TV Shopping Channels where she demonstrates chocolate making and equipment.

Encouraged by the enthusiasm of people for her diverse selection of chocolates and hand-made sweets, Julie has written a book called 'Chocolates from Steeple Bumpstead' and runs demonstrations at her chocolate workshop.
